About the Dance Garden

Ms Marian's Dance Garden is a **performance-focused** Dance Studio in San Francisco's Richmond District that opened in OCT, 2013.

It offers three **Schools of Movement** for:

- * Infants/Toddlers (6-36 mos) with their caregivers – Creative Movement

- * Kids (ages 3 – 18 yrs) - different levels of Ballet, Pointe, Tap, Contemporary, Pre K-TK

Creative Movement/Dance, Acro, Choreography, Boys Sports Movement/Boxing, School TOURS

- * Teen/Adult FIT program - Ballet FIT, Restorative Dance FIT, Tap, Choreography

ALSO: Private Classes in Tap, Ballet; Sewing Bees

ALSO: Summer and Winter Camps for all ages with emphasis on Arts and Crafts; Sewing; Musical Theatre; and more. These activities complement our dance training to build the well-adjusted, whole dancer.

Directed by Marian Roth-Cramer, BA, MFA. Ms Marian has 45+ years' experience as Performer, Teacher, Producer, Author and Company Director. Ms Marian is known for her individualized and nurturing style of teaching, her work in school systems, studio settings and the thousands of children she has influenced to discover the joy and wonder of Dance. In 1980, Ms Marian wrote a book for Early Childhood Educators (Pre K to 1st grade) presenting Creative Movement/Dance exercises as an alternative to traditional PE classes. She has created hundreds of events and productions. Ms Marian sits on SF Community Boards representing the Richmond District and Geary Blvd Merchants.

The Dance Garden is also a Training Center for Teachers, Students and Dancers, with the objective to grow educated, talented movers and shakers. DG students have earned spots in High School and Colleges of the Arts; employment in Dance Companies and in related fields of Education, the Arts, Production, and Design, as well as Engineering and Medical. A dancer learns discipline, physical and mental strength and flexibility - attributes that predict positive career outcomes.

Looking forward, The Dance Garden is working to create the Dance Garden Performing Arts Center - a multi-purpose space for training and performing in the grocery store beneath our studios. The City of San Francisco has been on the front line assisting to make this dream to come true. Our plans include: forming a non-profit entity, building a Board of Directors, writing Grants, hiring professionals to build a black box theatre and dance space available to our Dance Garden students and our Richmond District community artists.

Dress Code for the MMDG Children's Dance Program 2026

WHY a Dress Code?

Encourages a neat and tidy appearance; sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teacher, and the art of dance; allows teachers to see the line of the body clearly, in order to make proper corrections on posture, alignment, shape and form. **We wear REVOLUTION DANCE GEAR**

HOW to Prepare?

Choose a designated **DANCE BAG** and keep all your essentials inside...dance shoes, hair supplies (including hair ties, hair brush, small barrettes) extra tights, water bottle if necessary....the DG has spring water for students!

HAIR:

- > **GIRLS:** Secure hair with hair ties + barrettes; off of the face + neck, so hair doesn't distract your vision. You can borrow hair ties from the DG.
- > **PreK – 7th grades:** two high pigtails;
- > **8h – 12th grades:** one high pony tail or a ballet bun
- > **BOYS:** Hair should be out of eyes; the Dance Garden will supply the student with elastic headbands

DANCE GEAR:

PreK: pink footed tights; any color leotard; attached skirt OK; (no sequins or glitter), ballet slippers

K-12th/Ballet/Dance: pink or black tights; black leotard; ballet slippers

3rd-12th/Contemporary/Dance: convertible or footed tights; leotard; dance shorts; ballet slippers

Acro: black leotard/dance shorts; tights; Acro shoes

Tap: Leotard; tights or dance pants; tap shoes

Boys: White T shirt; black stretch pants; black ballet slippers

For ALL DANCERS in Class:

NO JEWELRY! NO GUM!
