Dress Code for the Infant/Toddler & Children's Dance Program

WHY a Dress Code?

It encourages a neat and tidy appearance; sets an attitude of attentiveness and respect for students, teacher, and the art of dance; allows teachers to see the line of the body clearly, in order to make proper corrections on posture, alignment, shape and form.

Check out each dance technique for dance attire and shoe requirements.

HOW to Prepare?

Choose yourself a designated **DANCE BAG** and keep all your essentials inside...dance shoes, hair supplies, extra tights, leotard, bottled water.

GIRLS: Secure hair with pony tail holders and barrettes; hair should be up off of the face and neck, so you can learn how to turn, move quickly, leap without having hair distract your vision. You can borrow hair ties from the DG.

PreK – 4th grades: two high pigtails;

5th – 12th grades: one high pony tail or a ballet bun

BOYS: Boys hair should be out of their eyes for all classes; the Dance Garden will supply the student with elastic headbands, aptly named “Ninja Headbands” to remain at the Dance Garden between classes

For All:

No jewelry! Be safe....don't hurt yourself or your fellow dancers!

No gum!...Be safe...don't choke!
